

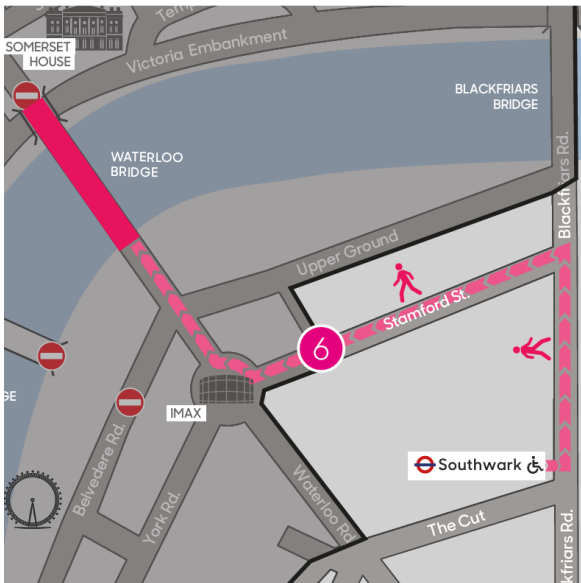
PINK 6 ENTRANCE

Getting to Your Entrance

Your entrance will **open at 8:00pm** and **close at 10:30pm**. Please ensure you arrive in plenty of time before your entrance closes. To access the **Pink 6** entrance, you must arrive via **Southwark Station** as other routes will be restricted or closed and this may lead to a delay in your arrival.

Road and footpath closures will be in place across central London from 2pm on the 31 of December. You should plan to use the Underground and National Rail services to reach Southwark Station and the Pink 6 entrance. Start planning your journey using the [TfL](#) and [National Rail](#) websites.

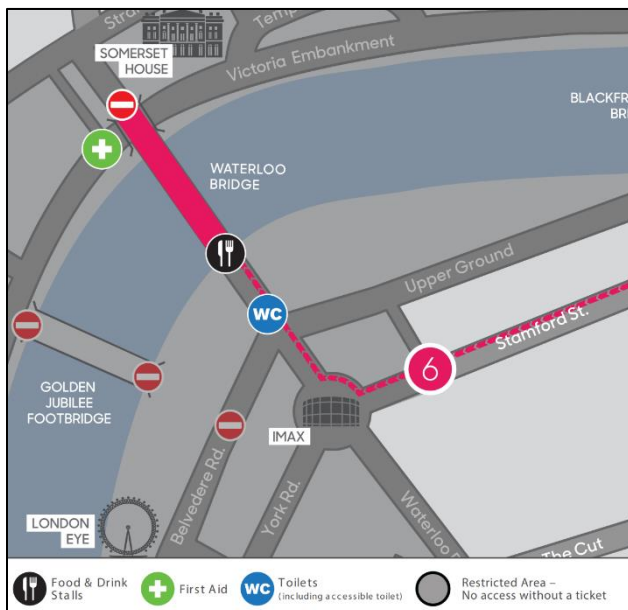

Underground: Jubilee Line

Walking Directions: Exit Southwark Station and turn **LEFT** onto Blackfriars Road. Follow Blackfriars Road towards the River Thames. After a 5-minute walk turn **LEFT** onto Stamford Street and follow the road straight down until you reach your stewarded Pink 6 entrance.

This is around a 10-minute walk and be sure to observe instructions from stewards and signage from the station exit.

Welfare Facilities
