

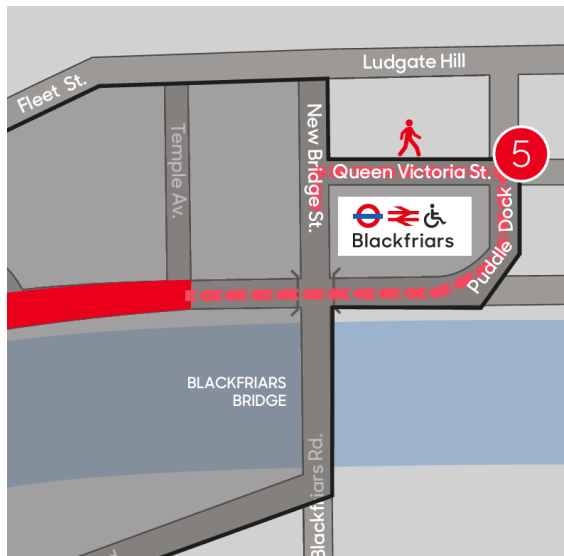
RED 5 ENTRANCE

Getting to Your Entrance

Your gate entrance will **open at 8:00pm** and **close at 10:30pm**. Please ensure you arrive in plenty of time before your entrance closes. To access the **Red 5** entrance, you must arrive via **Blackfriars Station** as other routes will be restricted or closed and this may lead to a delay in your arrival.

Road and footpath closures will be in place across central London from 2pm on the 31 of December. You should plan to use the Underground and National Rail services to reach Blackfriars Station and the Red 5 entrance. Start planning your journey using the [Tfl](https://www.tfl.gov.uk) and [National Rail](https://www.nationalrail.gov.uk) websites.

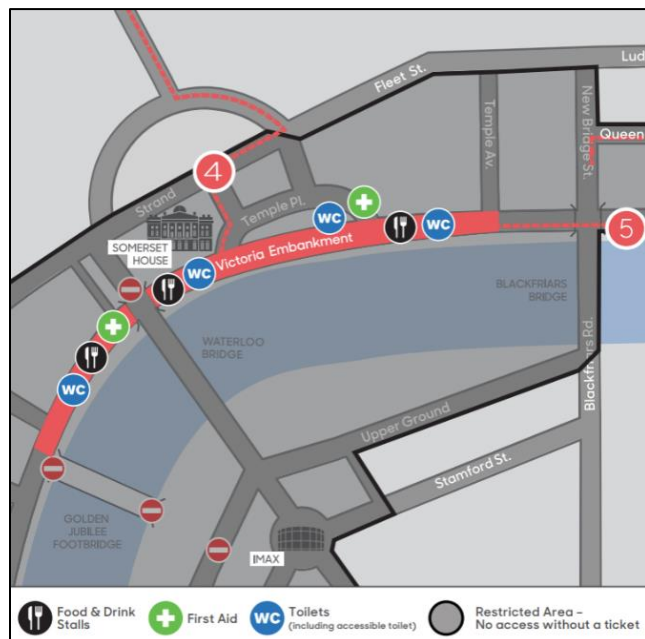
Mainline: Thameslink or East Midlands Railway.

Underground: District or Circle Line

Walking directions: Exit Blackfriars Station and turn **RIGHT**. Follow the road round onto Queen Victoria Street and continue straight. Turn **RIGHT** onto Puddle Dock (going under the bridge) until you reach the stewarded Red 5 entrance.

This is around a 5-minute walk and be sure to observe instructions from stewards and signage from the station exit.

Welfare Facilities
